



# OcuTrap R1 - Operation Cheat Sheet

Buttons, LEDs & device states — keep near the trap.

**First time setting up?** Follow the **R1 Quick Start** card (in the box) for battery, assembly, and app pairing. This cheat sheet is for day-to-day operation.

## SYSTEM LED (TOP OF POD)

Pattern	Meaning
Breathing cyan	Connected to cloud — operational.
Fast blinking cyan	Connecting to the cloud.
Blinking green	Searching for cellular signal.
Blinking magenta	Firmware update in progress.
Rapid red SOS	Firmware crash — contact support if >10 blinks.
Solid red at boot	Battery too low (<9.6V). Charge and retry.
No light	Off or hibernating. Press Power to wake.

## BUTTONS & CONTROLS

Action	How	Result
Arm	User Button, then Power Button	Door must be set open
Unarm	User Button, then Power Button	From armed state
Open door	User Button, release, then hold 5s	Blue flashes
Close door	User Button, release, then hold 5s	Green flashes
Power off	Hold Power Button 3s	Red blink → solid red → off
Reset	Press Reset once	Reboots; state preserved

## SAFETY

- Keep fingers clear of the door and motor at all times.
- Power off and disconnect the battery before any maintenance.
- Wear gloves when approaching a captured animal.
- Do not submerge. Avoid freezing conditions (door may stick).
- Use only the supplied charger.
